

Samuel Sunukjian, Vice President of Information Technology and Cybersecurity Services

Mr. Samuel Sunukjian joined MAR in August 2002 and is the Vice President of Information Technology (IT) and Cyber Security Services. Throughout his career in the IT field, Mr. Sunukjian has maintained a customer oriented philosophy that remains a focus of his organization. He has an extensive background in Program/Project Management, and Team Lead roles for IT projects as both a Federal Government employee and a Private Sector (government contractor) Executive. Over the last 10 years, he has expanded the company's IT capabilities into Information Assurance and Cyber Security support services. Mr. Sunukjian is responsible for the day-to-day operations of contracts under the company's IT and Cyber Security services group. He directs work under MAR GSA IT Schedule 70, GSA Alliant Small Business GWAC, Department of Homeland Security EAGLE II contract, Commodities Futures Trading Commission BPA, and the Nuclear Regulatory Commission Cyber Security Program Support Services contract. He is in charge of staffing, financial tracking, program oversight, and business development for programs and contracts within his Business Unit.
